With regard to offering of Open Electives for III Semester students it is clarified that:

- a) Science Students are required to study open electives from the Arts or Commerce & Management or other Streams not from the Science Screams.
- b) Arts Students are required to study open electives from the Science or Commerce and Management or other streams not from Arts Streams.
- c) Commerce and Management students are required to study open elective from Science or Arts or other streams not from Commerce and Management streams.

As per 4 year Under Graduate Programme, students are required to study 9 credit courses from other streams. Hence, there will not be 4<sup>th</sup> open elective paper in the second year.

Since, I Semester classes have already begun and the Syllabus is being taught, there will not be any change in the course structure and selection of open electives for the current Academic Year 2022-23. However the students have to opt open elective from other faculty subjects from 2023-24.
