The Government of Karnataka, by its Order No. ED 260 UNE 2019(part-1) dated 07.08.2021 has implemented the National Education Policy (NEP)-2020 from the academic year 2021-22. Based on the Model Program Structures and the Syllabus prepared by the Subject Experts Committees constituted by the Karnataka State Higher Education Council, the Boards of Studies in the Faculty of Commerce has framed new Syllabus for implementation from the academic year 2021-22.

The Academic Council at its meeting held on 12.10.2021 has approved the new Syllabus with <u>uniform pattern of 40:60 for IA and Semester End theory examinations</u> respectively and 50:50 for IA and Semester End practical examinations respectively for implementation from the academic year 2021-22. Accordingly, wherever the Internal Assessment (IA) and Theory examination and Practical Examination marks appearing in the Syllabus (including model question paper) stands modified as under:

. A) Theory Examinations(Total 100 Marks):

Internal Assessment Marks = 40 Marks Continuous assessment(C1)= 20 Marks Continuous assessment(C2)= 20 Marks Semester End examination(C3)= 60 Marks

B) Practical examination(Total 50 Marks):

IA Marks = 25 Theory Marks = 25 Accordingly, the following Syllabus for CBCS Semester Scheme with multiple Entry and Exit Options for UG Courses in the Faculty of Commerce are hereby notified for implementation from the academic year 2021-22.
