# **BCU EMERGE CHAMPS**

## Prevail Over BU Via Sudden Death

Bhubaneswar: Bengaluru Central University beat Bangalore University 5-4 (3-3) in a nail-biting shootout to take home the men's hockey gold in the Khelo India University Games here on Friday.

In a pulsating final - essentially between the trainees of Sports Authority of India and the Department of Youth Empowerment and Sports — Harish Somappa Mutagar scored a brace, in the 30th and 53rd minutes, to keep Bengaluru Central in the hunt all through the encounter. His team was down 0-2 by the second quarter with Bangalore University's CS Shamanth (11th) and Yathish Kumar B (24th) sounding the boards early in the match. Shortly after Harish's first goal, BU widened the lead to

3-1 with BP Somanna converting a penalty stroke. Harish reduced the margin a second time but BCU — who were denied repeatedly by BU goal-keeper and captain AC Subramani — had to wait till the 59th minute to find the equalizer, skipper Mohd Raheel Mouseen, finding the net off their 17th penalty corner.

Locked 3-3 after regulation time, the two Bangalore teams got down to the shootout, add-

ing further to the drama.

"We didn't start the match well but I am happy that we were able to come back in the game with an improved performance in the 3rd and 4th quarter," Raheel said.

In the shootout, the two teams missed two shots each for a stalemate at 3-3. Shamanth, Somanna and M Likith scored while Yathish and Pavan Madivalar missed for BU. For BCU, Punith and N Kumar and Raheel found the board

but Harish and S Nagesh failed in their attempt to beat the goalkeeper. In sudden death, Raheel and Shamanth scored to maintain the deadlock. Harish then scored for BCU while their goalkeeper Sanjay HT made the all-important save off F Pavan's attempt to carve out the victory.

With international hockey stars Deepak Thakur and Devesh Chauhan, who were here to scout talent for their company IOCL, seated in the spectator gallery, the players went all out to impress them. "It was a tense final, especially given our rivalry back home in Bengaluru. But we all knew about the IOCL scouts and tried to put up a good performance. I am happy we held our nerves till the end and won in sudden death," Raheel said.
